# Learner's Permit Restrictions

A	Must be at least 16 years old.
A	No driving alone. You must have a qualified trainer seated next to you at all times.
A	No passengers allowed in the vehicle besides a qualified trainer.
A	Seat belts must be worn by everyone present in the vehicle.
lack	No cell phones or hand held devices with a video screen - including GPS!

### Eligibility

## 16-17

#### **FOR 16-17 YEAR-OLDS**

You must hold your permit for at least 120 days (if completed commercial or secondary training) or 180 days (if completed training at home with a Qualified Trainer and completed the 8 Hour Safety Course which includes 2 hour Parent Class) before you can test for your license.



### 18+ YEAR-OLDS

You must hold your permit for 90 days & complete the 8 Hour Safety Course before you can test for your license.

### FAQ

### Who can be a Qualified Trainer?

Anyone at least 20 years of age, that has a minimum of 4 years of driving experience and no suspensions in the last 4 years.

### Can I practice driving with my parent if they do not have a license?

Nope. You can only practice with a qualified trainer or a licensed driving

#### Who else can be in the car with me?

Only a qualified trainer or a licensed driving instructor giving instruction, and others accompanying that instructor, are permitted in the vehicle while you are learning to drive.

### What are the consequences for driving alone with a permit?

If caught, you will have an extended waiting time before you can apply for a license, and you can also be issued a fine.
